

PRE-EVENT CONTEST RULES

Eureka!'s pre-event contest starts at 9 a.m on June 4, 2018 . and ends at 6 p.m. on June 7, 2018. This contest is part of the Eureka Festival! which is being held in the Old Port of Montréal from June 8 to 10, 2018. All references to time in this document refer to the time in effect locally in the City of Montreal, Province of Quebec.

1. How to enter

- 1- Like the Eureka! Festival page and the Nintendo Labo Facebook post;
- 2- In the comments, tell us which friend you would like to MAKE, PLAY and DISCOVER with at the Eureka! Festival using Nintendo Labo.

Winners agree to have their first and last name, age, and place of residence mentioned when the winners are announced on the Facebook page of the Eureka! Festival.

Only one entry per person, per Facebook account, is allowed.

No purchase is required.

2. Eligibility requirements

To be eligible for the contest, participants must reside in Canada and be 18 years of age or older.

By entering this contest, you agree to abide by the contest rules.

Directors, officers and employees of L'île du savoir, its parent companies and subsidiaries, advertising agencies, partners, sponsors and other service providers related to this contest, as well as members of their immediate families (brothers, sisters, children, father, mother, legal or common-law spouse) and persons living under the same roof, may not participate in this contest.

3. The prize

A Nintendo Labo set consisting of a Nintendo Switch system, a Nintendo Labo Multi-Kit and a Nintendo Labo Robot Kit, with a total value of \$590.

4. The draw

Reminder:

To participate, Facebook users need to comment on the post by telling us what they would like to make, play and discover with Nintendo Labo at the Eureka! Festival.. This promotion was not associated with, managed, approved or sponsored by Facebook.

The draw will take place at 8 pm on June 7, through the *Good Luck Fairy Karma fanpage* application. The winner will be contacted via personal Facebook message and must provide his/her email address to receive the prize.

Drawing procedure

One (1) random draw for all entries received no later than 6 pm on June 7, 2018. The draw will take place on June 7, at 8 pm, via The *Good Luck Fairy Karma fanpage website*.

The application selects winners (at random), according to different criteria. The criteria that will be used for this competition is:

- One winner among the users who commented on the post
- To be declared a winner, the randomly selected entrant must be a resident of Canada, 18 years of age or older, have duly commented on the Facebook post for the electronic contest, and have correctly answered the question: "With which friend would you like to make, play, and discover with Nintendo Labo at the Eureka! Festival."
- Failure to meet one or more of these conditions will automatically result in disqualification and another draw will be held to determine a new winner. The selected entrant will be contacted by message via the entrant's Facebook account, telling them how to collect their prize.
- L'île du savoir cannot be held responsible for any failed attempt to contact a selected entrant.
- Each selected entrant will have a maximum of one (1) day from the date he/she is contacted by message via Facebook to claim his/her prize. If the selected entrant cannot be contacted within twenty-four (24) hours of the draw, if the prize is not claimed within the maximum twenty-four (24) hour period, or if the entrant does not provide the information requested by L'île du savoir for the delivery of the prize, the entrant will be disqualified and another entrant will be randomly drawn from the remaining eligible entries until a new winner is declared.

5. General rules

5.1 Any Facebook contest entry comment that is incorrect, incomplete, incomprehensible, late, fraudulent or contains false information will automatically be rejected.

In addition, any entry or attempted entry using electronic, computer or other means contrary to the spirit of the contest (hacking, mass emailing, etc.) will be automatically rejected and may be referred to the appropriate judicial authorities. Any automated participation will be identified and rejected.

5.2 The winners irrevocably release L'île du savoir from all liability for any damage or loss that may result from participation in this contest or that may result from the awarding, acceptance or use of the prize or that may result from any services provided in connection with said prize.

5.3 The winner accepts the prize without any legal or other guarantee from the Released Parties.

5.4 The winner authorizes the contest organizers to use his/her name, place of residence, image, photograph, voice, statement or presence for advertising or other purposes related to this contest, without any restriction of time, media or territory, and without any form of compensation.

5.5 The winner's refusal to accept the prize releases the Parties from any liability and obligation towards the winner.

5.6 L'île du savoir reserves the right to modify, postpone or cancel this contest subject to obtaining authorization from the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec, if required.

5.7 The Released Parties assume no responsibility for the failure of any website used for the Contest, or for any problems or technical failures of any telephone network or line, computer online system, server, access provider, computer equipment, software, failure of any e-mail or transmission to be received due to technical or other problems, congestion on the Internet network or any website, or any combination thereof, including damage to the entrant's computer equipment, or any other person, that may result from participating in this Contest.

5.8 The Released Parties assume no liability for any loss, delay, address error, printing error or other error in connection with this Contest.

5.9 The Released Parties assume no liability of any nature whatsoever in all cases where their inability to act would result from an unforeseeable fact or situation beyond their control, including strikes, lockouts or any other labour dispute in their establishment or in the establishments of the organizations or companies whose services are used to hold this contest.

5.10 Personal information requested from entrants in connection with the contest will be used only by L'île du savoir or a third party authorized by L'île du savoir for the sole purpose of conducting the contest. This information will not be used for any other purpose without the consent of the participants and the parents and legal guardian. By providing this information, participants consent to their use for the purposes indicated.

5.11 Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec for a ruling. Any litigation respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.

5.12 In the event of unavailability due to factors beyond their control, the Released Parties reserve the exclusive and absolute right to substitute one prize for another of equivalent value and nature, without recourse for the winner.
