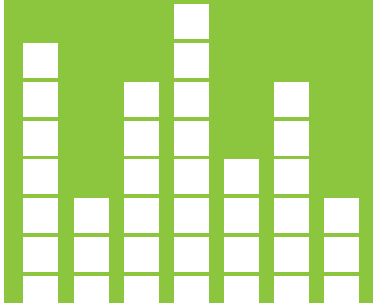




### ECO-RESPONSIBLE
